



Stadium Services for Guests with Disabilities

The Liberty Bowl Memorial Stadium and Fairgrounds strives to make every effort to guarantee that every guest enjoys their visit and offers the following facilities and services on the behalf of guests with disabilities. If you have any questions regarding facility services, please see the game day Guest Services representative at Section 120, located on the main concourse, between Gates 1 and 6. Parking

Parking for guests with disabilities is available in the lot, entered from South Hollywood via Access 3, and are first come first served. Guests parking in this lot must have a state-issued disability placard. Each vehicle is allowed one parking space. Operational staff is available to provide assistance upon request.

Drop-off and Pick-up

Guests can be dropped off and picked up on South Hollywood, outside Access 2.

Elevators

Elevators are located on the East side of the Stadium (between gates 1 and 6) and on the West side of the Stadium (between gates 3 and 4). Guests with disabilities having tickets with seating in rows 60 and above can access these elevators on game day.

Gates and Seating

Guests can enter the Stadium at Gate 4 and 6. The Liberty Bowl Memorial Stadium has wheelchair and companion seating with sideline and end zone sightlines, located on row 25. Guest entrances from the concourse into the bowl seating are located at Sections 109, 117, 122, and 124. For game day assistance for accessible routes and seating locations, see the Guest Services representative on the main concourse, or view the Circulation Map, on the reverse side of this document.

Assisted Listening Devices

Complimentary hearing amplification devices are available on game day at Guest Services, located on the main concourse at Section 120. Guest Services requires a valid ID or Drivers license as a security deposit, and devices must be returned prior to 30 minutes after the end of the game.

TTY

Tele-Typewriter service is available. Guests requiring use of this device should visit their game day Guest Services representative at Section 120 on the main concourse.

Concessions

The following concessions are accessible on the main concourse at the following sections: 101, 107, 109, 111, 116, 119-121, 129, 130, 132. Concession staff is available to assist guests at all other concession locations. Please see the concessionaire for details.

Emergency Evacuation Procedures

Liberty Bowl Memorial Stadium staff are trained in proper procedures for emergency situations. In the event of an evacuation, game day staff will assist and direct guests with disabilities to exit routes.

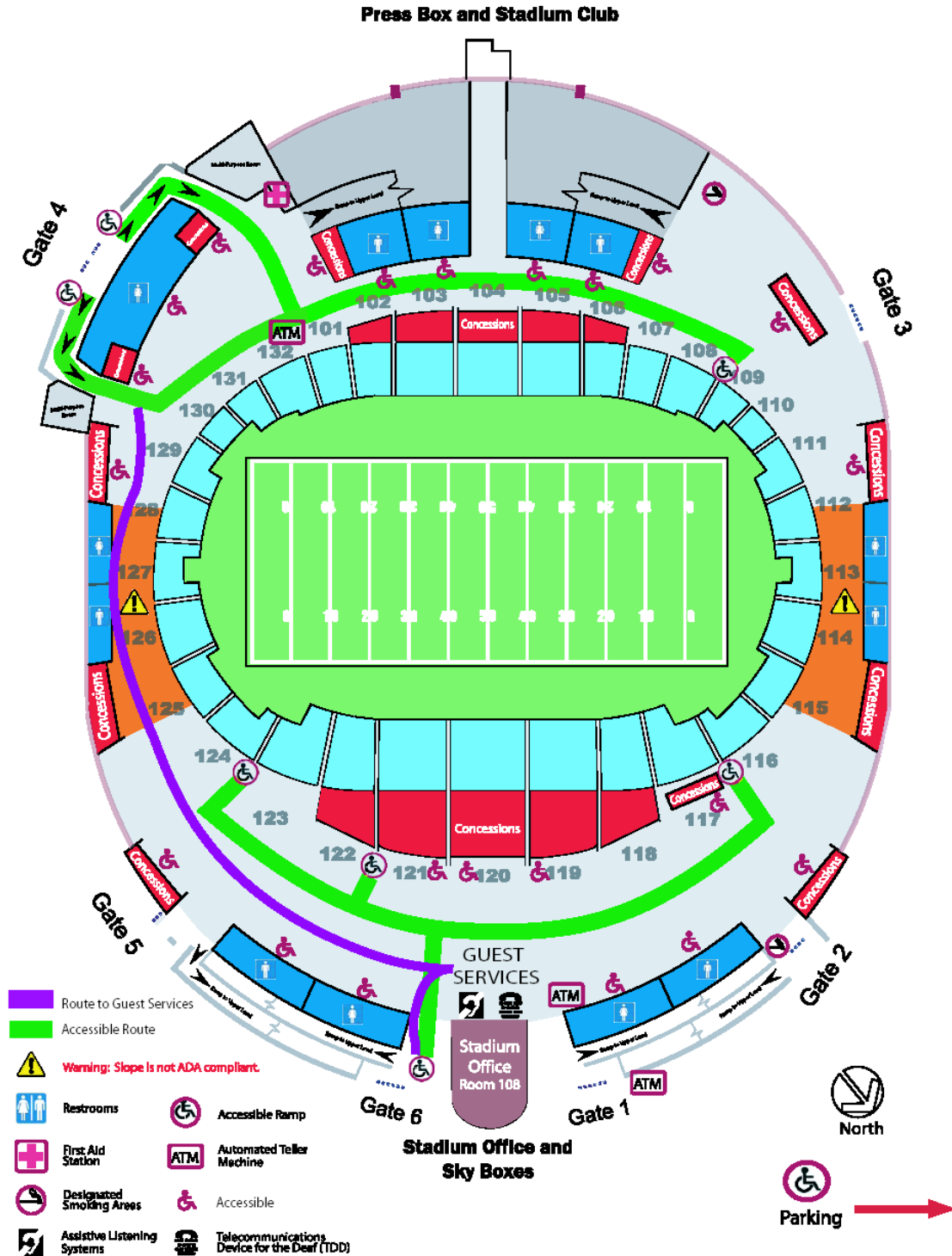
Restrooms

The following Mens (M) and Womens (W) restrooms are accessible on the main concourse: 102 (MW), 103 (MW), 105 (MW), 106 (MW), 118 (MW), 119 (MW), 121 (MW), 122 (MW), and 130-132 (W). Family/Companion Restrooms are located at Section 132.
